**There is currently a huge effort going on to coordinate and synchronise a campaign within rural Africa. This campaign has the aim of beginning many new village groups for the Life! Initiative and to also begin the initiative in many new areas.**

**At the village level we have encouraged our area leaders to identify new villages and new people. They will then run training and preparation for those in the bush to spread the work.**

**Between 22nd and 26th July, around 35 people from various areas of Zambia will come together to hear and learn about how they can plant the work in their own areas. We hope they will become the planters in their own areas.**

**Personally Jude and I have currently begun some work in the area of Chilata nr Mkushi, we have organised to show the Jesus film and are actively looking for the right people to form a team in the area. We hope to do this in one or two other areas as well.**
