## **Pray that the Fire will Burn...**

**Jon and Jude's time in Zambia for 2009 is coming to an end. They have been joined by Jo hardy and Cornelius Chalwe in planting the work in Mkushi and Nchelenge and the initial signs are that things are starting well.**

**It has at times been a hard 3 months. Lots of uncertainty, up and downs and travel, but God has led the way and there are now three Life! teams within Zambia and many more people who are leading groups in their village.**

**We hope that about fifteen groups will begin in the sprawling village area of Nchelenge and around seven groups in the Mkushi area. One or two new groups have also sprouted in the Chingola area.**

**Just over a year ago, I was approached by a man in St Pauls Worcester, in the UK, who encouraged me, "the fires we start will spread like bush fire and no amount of fire fighting from the enemy will put them out". That is a fantastic encouragement and we need to align our prayer with it.**

**Pray that the fire will burn. Pray that it will get more intense. Pray that more villagers will take up the call to reach and help their own localities...**

- Pray for the team of six people who comprise the team in Mkushi. Pray for Peter, Laston, Julius, Sharon, Morris and David. Pray that they will work well together and serve one another as the work begins.
- Pray for the team of four people who currently comprise the work in Nchelenge. Pray for Cornelius, Augustine, John and Kabungo. They are representing and organising villagers from a radius of some 80km, no small task.
- Pray for the team in Chingola area that are currently experiencing some growing pains. Pray that they would be united and that in the next few months they would successfully be able to add more to their team.
- Pray for the villages in Mkushi, Nchelenge and Lufwanyama areas. Pray that God himself will bring the Christians and community together.
- Pray that groups like the Seventh Day Adventists and Jehovah's Witnesses would be open to the new fellowship groups beginning and that this would lead to great change.
