Pray, Make a Difference...

Pray for Chingola, Zambia

The Life! initiative has now been underway in Chingola for one year. A small trem continue to support the 19 groups meeting in the area as well as seeking to plant new groups.

In September a short term team visited the groups around Chingola and ran a conference with them. The aim of the conference was to help the Life! groups as they begin to seek ways in which they can have a practical impact on their villages, a result of their growing relationship with God.

It is exciting to see the ways in which God has been at work in the villages around Chingola since we were last there, and to hear stories of transformation and growth. One of the most encouraging things we are seeing is increased unity amongst previously divided church groups. Alongside this, people are beginning to realise that God can work through them to make a difference in their village!

As well as continuing to encourage our friends in Chingola, the next month will see us running conferences in Nchelenge and Mkushi to help get Life! groups up and running in these areas.

Pray that those in the villages will be inspired by God!

- Pray for those overseeing the work in Chingola. Pray they will be sustained and that God will raise up other dedicated men to work alongside them in the rural areas, freeing up their time, energy and resources.
- Pray for continued increase in the unity between churches. When the church stands together it can be a much stronger witness to God than when it is divided.
- Many villagers lives are dictated by customs, traditions and witchcraft. Pray for freedom from these and the breaking of strongholds over villages.
- Pray for the Life! groups to know each other and have a greater impact over their areas as they work together.
- Pray that the groups will have self-supporting minds and not be trapped in the dependency that is so prevalent here. Pray that they will rely on Christ rather than waiting for outside help to arrive.
- Pray for the conferences in Nchelenge and Mkushi, that the right people will attend and the message God has for them will be clearly communicated.
